## What is Child Exploitation?

Child exploitation is when an abuser takes advantage of a young person for their own personal gain. This can take many forms, including sexual exploitation or forcing the child to commit crime. The most common form of criminal exploitation is when a child is forced to sell drugs for an older person.

**Some facts about Child Sexual Exploitation** 

Parents are often the first to notice something is wrong. Trust your instincts and talk to your child if you're wo rried.

Have they a boyfriend, girlfriend or friends including adults who you don't know?

Have you noticed them getting presents, money, a mobile phone or jewellery?

Have they been missing from home, staying out overnight or missing school?

Do they ge t picked up or dropped off by unknown people?

Are they secretive about where they go and who they see?

Do they chat to people online who they've never met?

Do you know what they're accessing online?

Are they drinking or taking drugs regularly?
